


Main figures of Groupe 3S in 2019

- First-rate customers such as Air France, Aéroports de Paris, Grands Ports Maritimes français, Chambres de Commerce et d'Industrie, etc.




Groupe 3S key figures for 2019

Alyzia, The latest affiliate of Groupe 3S






- In 2012, Groupe 3S became the main shareholder of ALYZIA with 80% of the share capital. Groupe 3S became the first private ground handler in France.





Our new simulator is equipped with 5 fire points and a smoke generator. Exercises may focus on extinguishing or removing pilots and passengers


